<p><b>In Document A, Description of Installation, after “These procedures occur in the “Lower Organic” manufacturing area and the organic packing area” insert new paragraph:</b></p> <p>There is a technically linked process known as the SVC plant where solvent mixing occurs. The raw materials are mixed in a 5,000L non-pressure rated mixing tank that is vented into the existing extraction system. The charging of raw materials to the tank is from a dedicated clean air booth that also has LEV from the existing system. The product is generally dispensed into 200L drums and 1,000L IBC’s directly from the mixing tank.</p> <p><b>In Document A, Clause 3.7 insert:</b></p> <p>The headspace shall be maintained at a pressure of between 4 and 20 mbarg.</p> <p><b>In Document A, clause 3.8 delete:</b></p> <p>The PGMEA bulk storage tank shall not be vented to atmosphere except in emergency via the bursting disk and flame trap</p> <p><b>And insert:</b></p> <p>The PGMEA bulk storage tank shall be fitted with a pressure vacuum relief (PVR) valve. The tank shall only vent to atmosphere in the event of the pressure in the headspace of the tank exceeding 20 mbarg. In case of a failure of the PVR valve, the tank shall be fitted with a bursting disk and flame trap that shall only</p>	<p>Immediately</p> <p>Immediately</p> <p>Immediately</p>

<p>operate in the event of an emergency, where the pressure in the headspace exceeds 0.1 barg.</p> <p><b>In Document A, insert new clause:</b></p> <p>3.22 Prior to disposal, used wipes and other items contaminated with organic solvent shall be placed in suitably labelled metal bins that are fitted with self-closing lids.</p> <p><b>In Document A, insert new clause:</b></p> <p>3.23 The pressure vacuum relief valve, the bursting disk and the flame trap serving the bulk PGMEA storage tank shall be inspected, cleaned and maintained as required at least once every six months.</p>	<p>Immediately</p> <p>Immediately</p>
