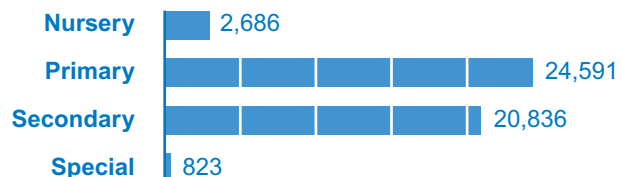

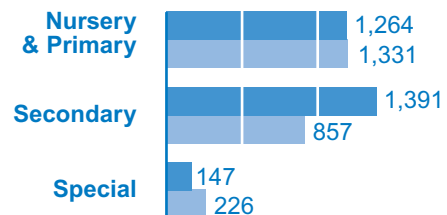

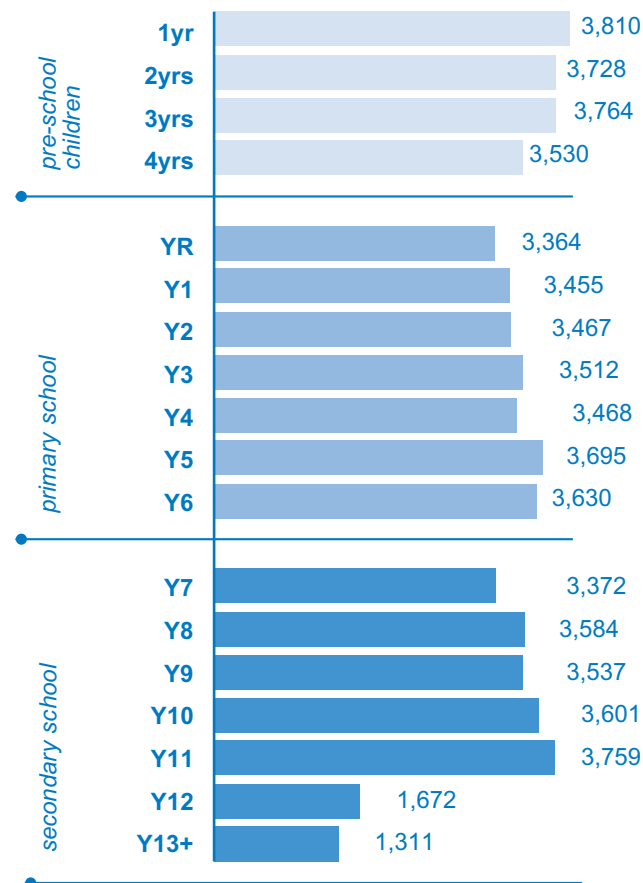

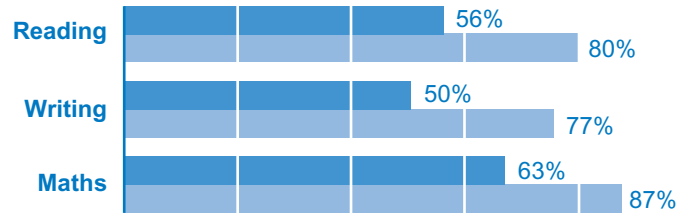

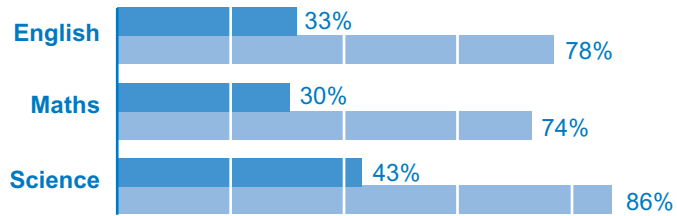
Education Attainment of Children Looked After

KS2: Percent attaining Level 4+

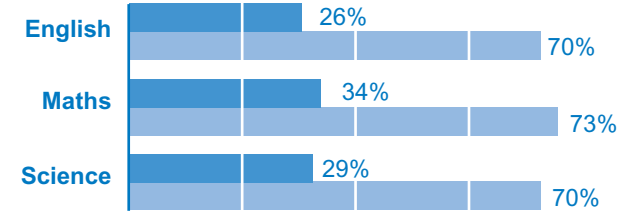

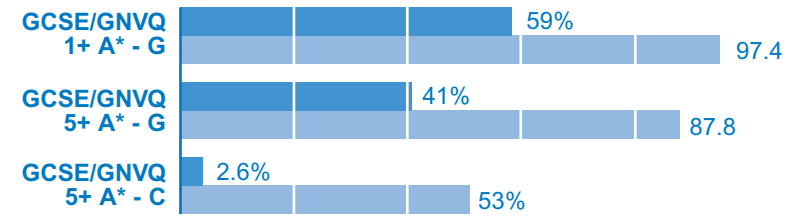

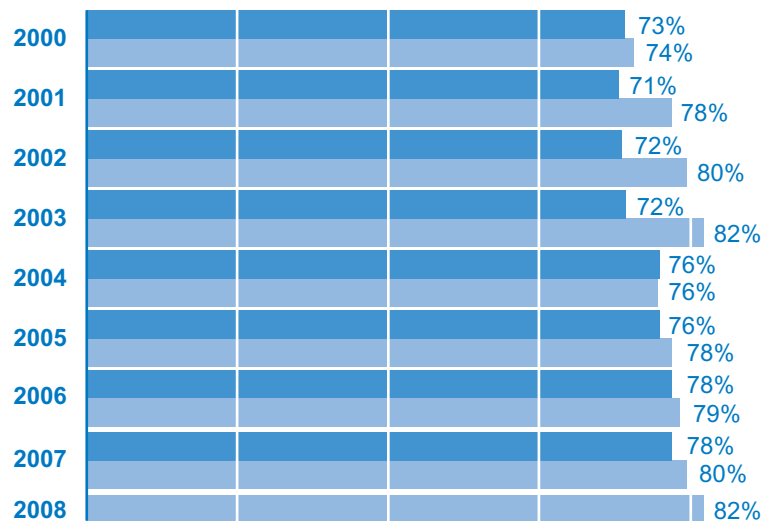

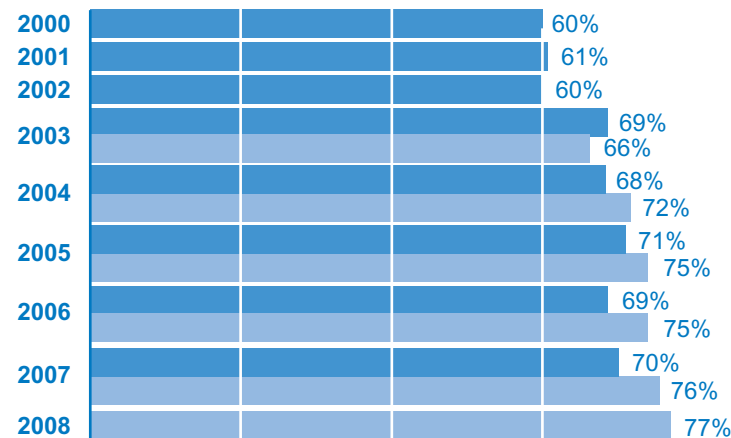

KS2 English: Percent attaining Level 4+



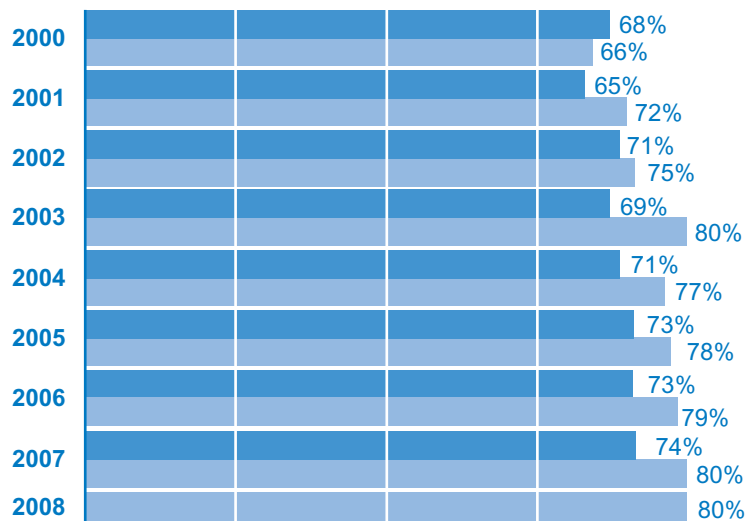
% of Y6 Pupils

KS3 English: Percent attaining Level 5+



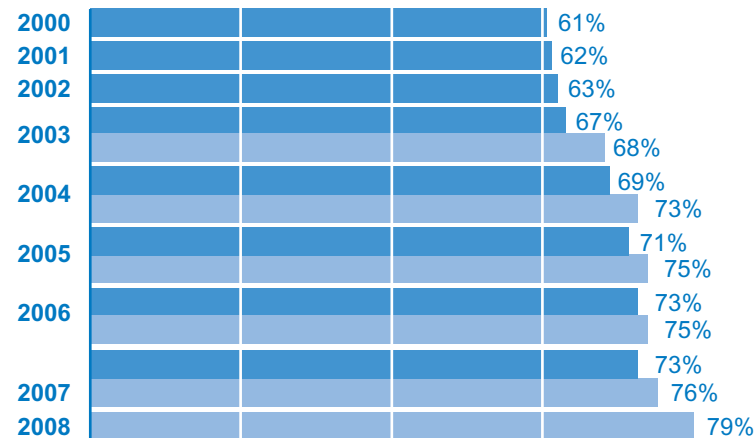
% of Y9 Pupils

% of Y6 Pupils

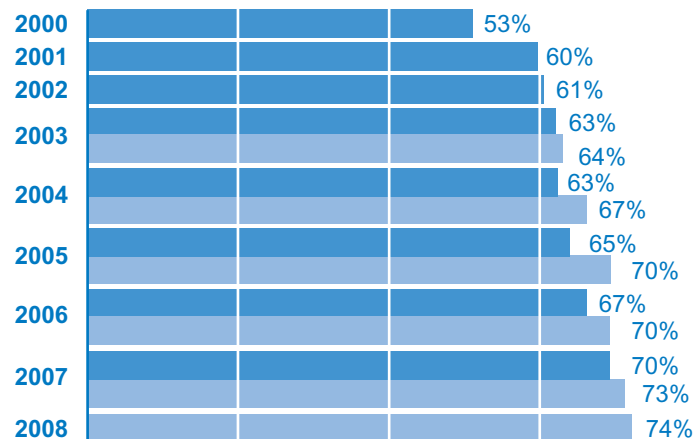
KS3 Mathematics: Percent attaining Level 5+

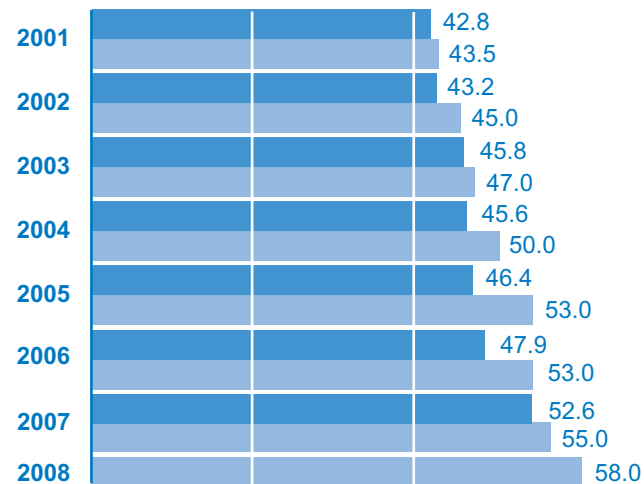

KS3 Science: Percent attaining Level 5+



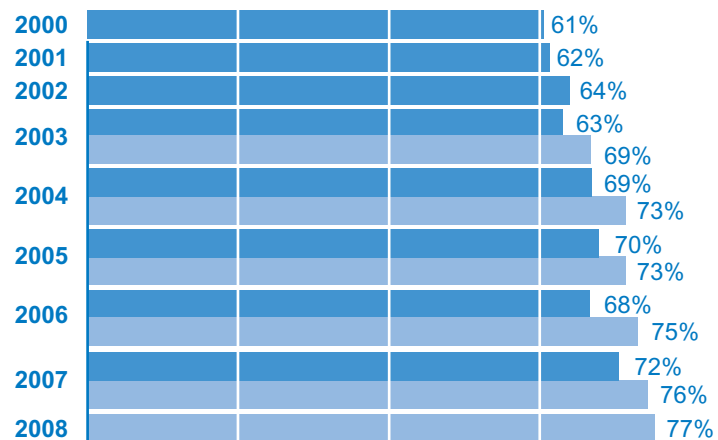

KS4 GCSE/GNVQ: Percent attaining 5+ A*-C



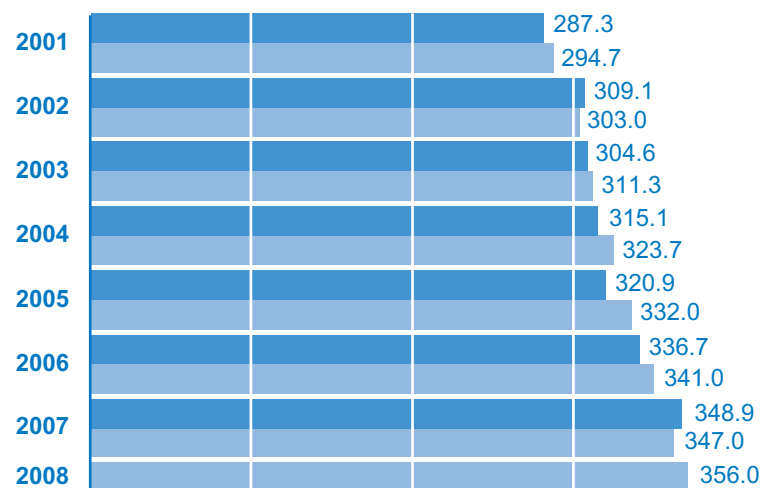
% of Y11 Pupils

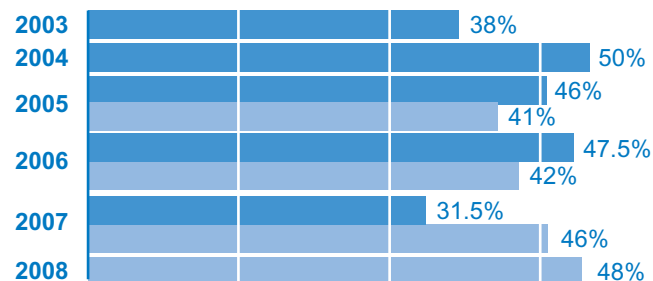

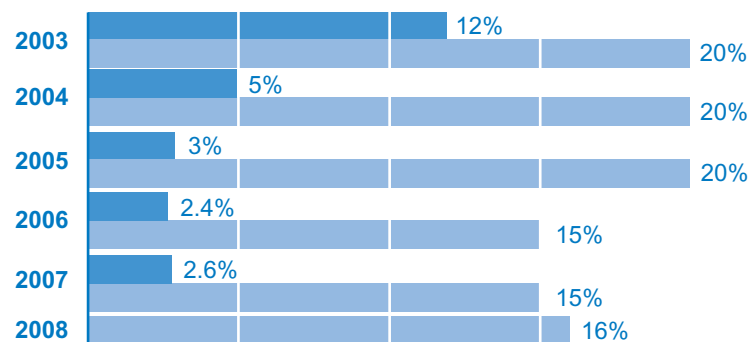
