





Whitley Depot Environmental Policy

This policy applies to the on-site activities of the Facilities Management (Repairs and Maintenance), Streetscene & Regulatory Services (Whitley Depot Management, Commercial Waste, Waste Services, Parks & Open Spaces, Streetpride, Passenger Transport, Integrated Transport Unit, Taxi Licensing), Transport & Highways (Highways) and Customer Services at Whitley Depot.

- Operate and maintain an environmental management system that meets the requirements of ISO14001 to demonstrate our commitment to environmental management.

- Make this policy available to interested parties to demonstrate our commitment to protect the environment.
- Review and revise the policy to reflect changing conditions and information.
