Thank you for your request for information relating to Carbon Footprint and Carbon Emissions.

Your request:

**1. Please can you clarify if you have calculated the carbon footprint of your local authority area. If so what are your local authority area carbon footprint per capita and carbon emissions per capita.**

The Government (Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy) reports all authorities' carbon emissions on an annual basis. The most up-to-date report, which was published on the 27<sup>th</sup> June 2019, provides carbon emission data from 2005-2017. Coventry's total carbon emissions within the year 2017 were 1,329.3 kt CO<sub>2</sub>, with a population of 360,100. This means that Coventry had per capita emissions of 3.69 t.
