

Discriminatory Abuse

Discrimination is abuse that focuses on a difference or perceived difference of a person with care and support needs.

For example, harassment, ill-treatment, threats or insults because of a person's race, gender, age, culture, gender identity, religion, sexuality, physical or learning disability or mental health need. Discriminatory abuse can also be called 'hate crime'.
