Domestic Abuse means physical, sexual, emotional or financial abuse of a person with care and support needs by someone who is a family member or who is/has been in a close relationship with the person being abused.

For example, threats, violence or controlling behaviour, either as a one-off incident or a pattern of incidents. It also includes forced marriage, female genital mutilation (FGM) and honour-based violence.
