Thank you for your request for information relating to idling vehicle offences.

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

Under the Freedom of Information Act, please provide me with the following details:

1) How many Fixed Penalty Notices or Penalty Charge Notices has your council issued to motorists who have unnecessarily left their engine idling when stationary – a violation of the The Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986.

2020 – up to the latest month available.

This legislation has not been adopted in Coventry, therefore the response is nil.

2) Does your council have a system in place where users can report motorists who leave their engines unnecessarily idling to the council?

We can advise that the Council does not have a system in place.
