Thank you for your request for information relating to Pedestrian Crossings with White Globe Beacon.

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

I am looking to find out the locations of Pedestrian 'Centre Island' crossings in Coventry City Council. Please can you provide me with the following information:

- 1. A list of all the pedestrian crossings marked with a white centre island globe beacon within Coventry City Council boundaries.
- 2. Information on how many 'White centre island globe beacons' on each crossing point.

The above would ideally include the use of the Geo-coordinate system information of each site, but also the street name and location.

In response to questions 1 & 2, we do not have white globes on pedestrian crossings but to assist you further, we advise that we do have lighting columns on centre refuges as below:

We have 24 locations in the city where there is lighting on the refuges as follows:

Holyhead Road X2

Brade Drive X3

Grange Road X2

Bell Green Road

Hollyfast Road

Greyfriars Road X4

Forfield Road X2

Quinton Park X2

Quinton Road X2

Banner Lane X2

Coat Of Arms Bridge Road X2

Tile Hill Lane
