Thank you for your request for information relating to Speed limit.

Your request and our responses are outlined below:

**1.The question I am asking you if you have the information is 'Can I have a comprehensive list of all roads under your control in which the speed limit has been permanently raised that was not for the purpose of becoming a dual carriageway?'**

We can confirm that we have not permanently increased any speed limits in Coventry for at least 20 years.

We do hold paper records from before this period however we are currently unable to check these records due to current access being restricted under COVID safety guidelines. If you would like us to access these records, you may wish to re-submit your request when the Government guidelines have been relaxed and we have been able to return to the office premises.

The supply of information in response to a freedom of information request does not confer an automatic right to re-use the information. You can use any information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research without requiring further permission. Similarly, information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting. An exception to this is photographs.
