Thank you for your request for information relating to Consultations with LGBT+ organisations for the Rainbow Crossing.

Your request and our response is shown below:

Regarding the LGBT+ Rainbow Crossing installed in November 2020 near the Bull Yard, please can you tell me if any LGBT+ organisations / businesses etc. were consulted prior to installation and if so, please can you name them.

With regards to consultation with LGBT+ communities, this was done through the Coventry PRIDE organisers following a member of the PRIDE group contacting the Council through a Councillor.

The crossing was discussed with the traders back in March 2020 leading up to the PRIDE event, which was unfortunately cancelled. A commitment was made to install the crossing which the Council completed.

The supply of information in response to a freedom of information request does not confer an automatic right to re-use the information.
