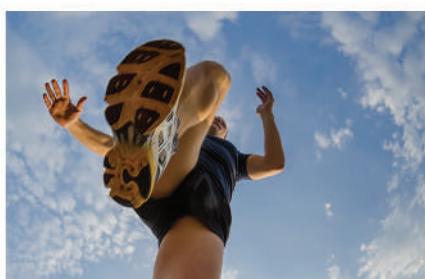


# A CAREER IN SPORT
