

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER
City of Coventry (New Century Park) (20mph Zone) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

It is proposed to implement a 20mph zone within New Century Park, a residential area with existing traffic calming features. The general effect of this proposal will be to restrict vehicular traffic from travelling at speeds greater than 20mph on the lengths of roads listed below:
