

Notice of Intent

**Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossings and Road Hump (Raised Table)
Abbotts Lane & Middleborough Road**

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Section 90 of the Highways Act 1980 (in respect of the proposed raised crossing) (as amended), intends to install controlled crossings on the following roads.

Abbotts Lane	Raised controlled crossing (parallel crossing) 50mm high to be located on Abbotts Lane approximately 51.5 metres west of its junction with Mill Street
Middleborough Road	Controlled crossing (zebra crossing) to be located on Middleborough Road approximately 68 metres west of its junction with Mill Street

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Highways Act 1980, intends to install a road hump (raised table) 50mm high at the following location:

Middleborough Road	Raised table 50mm high to be located on Middleborough Road approximately 5 metres northeast of the north-eastern boundary of 59 Middleborough Road, at the entrance to Naul's Mill Park.

A parallel crossing is a controlled crossing for use by both pedestrians and cyclists. The parallel crossing uses the zebra crossing layout for pedestrians, with a cycle route marked alongside. The proposed parallel crossing should assist both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road.

The proposed controlled crossings and raised features are part of wider cycle network proposals and will assist to improve access and safety, linking Coundon Cycleway and other future developments to the city centre and be completed by the end of Summer 2022.
