

Notice of Intent
Proposed Installation of Controlled Pedestrian Crossing (PUFFIN) facilities

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to introduce controlled pedestrian crossing facilities (PUFFIN) within the existing traffic signal controlled junctions at the following locations.

The controlled crossing facilities (PUFFIN) will be located at the junctions of:

Beake Avenue/Burnaby Road	On each arm of the existing traffic signal controlled junction (four (4) crossings)
Sewall Highway/Blackberry Lane	On each arm of the existing traffic signal controlled junction (four (4) crossings)
Sewall Highway/Bell Green Road	On each arm of the existing traffic signal controlled junction (four (4) crossings)
Humber Road/Bolingbroke Road	On Humber Road on the northern arm of the existing traffic signal controlled junction and on Bolingbroke Road (two (2) crossings) at the existing traffic signal controlled junction

The proposed crossing facilities should assist pedestrians to cross the roads at these junctions. The works should be completed by the end of March 2023
