

Notice of Making

CITY OF COVENTRY (BIGGIN HALL CRESCENT) (NO ENTRY) ORDER 2022

Coventry City Council, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Order ("the Order"), which comes into operation on 5th August 2022.

The Order forms part of changes to facilitate and enhance the safety of users of the highway, particularly the Binley Cycleway. Binley Cycleway is a scheme connecting the City Centre with University Hospital Coventry and Warwickshire proposed to encourage people to cycle.

The effect of the Order shall be to prevent vehicles (except pedal cycles) entering Biggin Hall Crescent from Binley Road.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder, or of any relevant Act, has not been complied with may, within six (6) weeks from today, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
