Notice of Intent

Proposed Installation of New & Amendments to Existing Controlled Crossings Upper Well Street & Ringway St Nicholas on/off slips

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install controlled crossings and make amendments to existing controlled crossings on the following roads.

| Ringway St Nicholas clockwise on slip | Toucan crossing replacing the existing controlled crossing (pedestrian) on Ringway St Nicholas clockwise on slip at a point approximately 25 metres northeast of its junction with Ringway Junction 9 |

| Ringway St Nicholas anti-clockwise off slip | Toucan crossing replacing the existing controlled crossing (pedestrian) on Ringway St Nicholas anti-clockwise off slip at a point approximately 13 metres northeast of its junction with Ringway Junction 9 |
| Upper Well Street | Parallel crossing to be installed on Upper Well Street approximately 10 metres southeast of its junction with Lamb Street |

A parallel crossing is a controlled crossing for use by both pedestrians and cyclists. The parallel crossing uses the zebra crossing layout for pedestrians, with a cycle route marked alongside. The proposed parallel crossing should assist both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road.

The works are part of improvements to convert the temporary cycleway linking the Canal Basin to Upper Well Street into a permanent arrangement, with improved pedestrian and cycle crossing facilities. The works should assist to improve access and safety and be completed by the end of 2022.
