

Notice of Intent
Proposed Installation of Controlled Pedestrian Crossing (Zebra)
Moseley Avenue

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install a controlled (Zebra) crossing on Moseley Avenue, approximately one hundred and twelve (112) metres south-west of its junction with Barker's Butts Lane.

The works will assist to provide a safer crossing point for pedestrians, particularly for children attending Moseley Primary School, and also for pedestrians visiting Moseley Avenue Park. The works should be completed by the end of May 2023.
