

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Butts) (Prohibition of U Turns) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

It is proposed to restrict vehicles from making a U turn manoeuvre on Butts from its junction with Sovereign Row to its junction with Albany Road/Butts Road. The general effect of this proposal will be to extend the existing 'No U-Turn' order currently operating from Sovereign Row to a point 60m south east from that junction, up to and including the Albany Road/Butts Road junction. Restricting vehicular traffic travelling on Butts making a "U" turn so as to proceed in the opposite direction on Butts. This will assist to improve road safety.
