Thank you for your request for information relating to cost of coronation events and 'big screens'.

You have requested the following information:

- 1. The cost / amount budgeted for any big screen events (public events screening the coronation) <https://www.gov.uk/government/news/big-screens-to-go-up-across-the-country-to-show-coronation>**
- 2. The amount that was allocated or offered by the Department for Culture, Media and Sport to the authority for 'big screen' events or any other coronation events**
- 3. Any information you hold on the cost of any coronation activities in the area**

In response to this request, we can advise that anticipated costs for city dressing, such as flags and banners, street party road closures and city centre events including Big Screen events is £45k.

We have also received £15k in funding (£10k Chamber of Commerce and £5k, WMCA) so the net cost to the Council is £30k.

The supply of information in response to a FOI/EIR request does not confer an automatic right to re-use the information. You can use any information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research without requiring further permission. Similarly, information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting. An exception to this is photographs.
