<u>Headline Criteria Four: Promoting Recovery and Reducing Harm from Substance Use</u>

No.	Criteria	Outcome
4.1	An adult has a drug and/ or alcohol problem	Adult reducing/ abstaining from substance use AND adult better equipped to manage the substance use. Adult understands the risk/ impact of the substance use on the family and children and is able to promote safety and implement actions to reduce harm AND Assessment undertaken with child/ family to determine impact of substance misuse on the family- family is benefitting from substance misuse work
4.2	A child or young person has a drug and/ or alcohol problem	Child reducing. Abstaining from substance use AND family/ child better equipped to manage the substance use and find alternative coping strategies, and understand risk/ impact of substance use
