Headline Criteria Ten: Financial Stability



Number	Criteria	Outcome
10.1	Adult in the family is workless (on out of work benefits)	Adult is in work OR Adult has made progress to work (training, volunteering, attended job interviews) OR Barriers to work have been removed or reduced
10.2	Family require support with their finances and/ or have unmanaged debt	Family feel able to manage their finances AND/ OR debt is being managed or has been resolved
10.3	Young person is NEET	Young person is in education, employment, or training

Support to access travel expenses for interviews	Support to access English, ESOL or Maths classes
Living with confidence course	Volunteering Opportunities
Financial Assessment	Removing barriers to work- childcare
