

Notice of Intent

Proposed Establishment of Cycle Track & Installation of Controlled Crossings (Toucans) Lynchgate Road

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under sections 65 (1), 65(2) and 66 of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby propose to introduce sections of Segregated and Unsegregated Cycle Track along lengths of Charter Avenue, Sir Henry Parkes Road, Shultern Lane and Lynchgate Road.

Notice is also hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install controlled (Toucan) crossings on the following roads.

Lynchgate Road	Toucan crossing at a point approximately 17 metres south of its junction with the access into Cannon Park Shopping Centre
Lynchgate Road	Toucan crossing south of its roundabout junction with Sir Henry Parkes Road. The crossing will be formed by 2 Toucans separated by the central splitter island. The Toucan crossing on the northbound carriageway approximately 5m south of the roundabout junction and the Toucan crossing on the southbound carriageway approximately 16m south of the roundabout junction

The works are part of improvements to the existing cycle route linking the city centre with the University of Warwick campus. The works should assist to improve access and safety and be completed by the end of March 2024.
