

Notice of Intent
Proposed Installation of Controlled Pedestrian Crossing (TOUCAN) facilities
London Road/Abbey Road Junction

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to introduce a traffic signal controlled junction at London Road/Abbey Road with controlled pedestrian crossing facilities (TOUCAN) at the following locations.

The controlled crossing facilities (TOUCAN) will be located:

London Road	On the northwest arm of the proposed signalised junction (the Toucan crossing) at a point approximately 6 metres northwest of its junction with Abbey Road
London Road	On the southeast arm of the proposed signalised junction (the Toucan crossing) at a point approximately 7 metres southeast of its junction with Abbey Road
Abbey Road	On the Abbey Road arm of the proposed signalised junction (the Toucan crossing) at a point approximately 4m southwest of its junction with London Road

The proposed crossing facilities should assist pedestrians and pedal cyclists to cross the road at this junction. The works should be completed by the end of March 2024
