CONSULTATION ON ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE DIOCESE OF COVENTRY MULTI ACADEMY TRUST ACADEMIES FOR THE YEAR 2026-27

The Directors of the Diocese of Coventry Multi Academy Trust are currently determining proposed admission arrangements for admissions to its academies in September 2026. As determined by the School Admissions Code, we are required to consult on these arrangements at least once every 7 years or when significant changes are made, and are inviting comments on the proposed changes.

Whilst this is a trust wide policy, the individual school admissions arrangements are included as Appendix 1.

The 2026-27 policy includes the following updates from the previous policy:

- A change to the over-subscription criteria for Queens to include a paragraph in relation to admissions to the Special Resource Provision (SRP) that is expected to be implemented in the academy from April 2025.
- An update to the definition of a Church for schools with faith criteria (Harris, Leigh and St Nicolas) as well as in the Faith Place Supplementary form included as Appendix 2 of the policy document.
- An update to the over-subscription criteria for St John's to introduce Faith criteria as there is a
 wide variety of local schools for parents to chose from and so faith criteria widen opportunities
 for inclusion and supports the close and vibrant connection of the school with St Christopher's,
 allowing those who are looking for this type of Christian education to access it even if they live
 outside of the local vicinity.
