PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (St Martins Road) (Prohibition of U Turn) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

It is proposed to restrict vehicles from making a U-turn manoeuvre on St Martins Road at its junction with Erithway Road. The general effect of this proposal will be to prevent southbound vehicles travelling on St Martins Road from performing a U-turn at its traffic signalised junction with Erithway Road so as to proceed in the opposite direction on St Martins Road. This will assist to improve road safety.
