

Notice of Intent

Proposed Installation of Controlled Crossings – Earlsdon Liveable Neighbourhood

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install controlled crossings on the following roads.

Albany Road	Toucan crossing to be located on Albany Road approximately 30 metres north of its junction with Newcombe Road
Earlsdon Street	Zebra crossing to be located on Earlsdon Street approximately 10 metres southwest of its junction with Poplar Road

The works are part of the Earlsdon Liveable Neighbourhood, a scheme proposed to create more social space within the highway, with more attractive environments for walking and cycling. The works should assist to improve access and safety and be completed by the end of Summer 2024.
