

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Watery Lane, Parish of Allesley) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

Coventry City Council proposes to introduce Prohibition of Driving restrictions on a section of Watery Lane in the Parish of Allesley. The intention of these restrictions is to prevent the Watery Lane / Clay Lane corridor from being used as a through route between Corley Moor and Harvest Hill to improve safety for non-motorised road users along the route. The restriction will also address issues raised by local residents relating to antisocial activities such as fly-tipping and late night congregations, by reducing access through this area.

Road and proposed restriction	Extents
Watery Lane, Parish of Allesley Prohibition of Driving except for access to nominated frontagers and organisations	From a point 726 metres south of its junction with Wall Hill Road to a point 9 metres north-east of its junction with Clay Lane
Watery Lane, Parish of Allesley Prohibition of driving except for access to off-street premises and to nominated frontagers and organisations as above	From a point 304 metres south of its junction with Wall Hill Road to a point 726 metres south of that junction
