Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: FOI577679028

Thank you for your request for information relating to rocks on verges.

You have requested the following information:

I would like to know how many complaints have been received by Coventry City Council relating to rocks placed on verges contrary to the Highways Act in the year 2023.

We hold the information which you have asked for, but we have estimated that the cost of meeting your request would exceed the cost limit of £450 specified in the Freedom of Information and Data Protection (Appropriate Limit and Fees Regulations 2004). This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 18 hours or more, in determining whether the information is held, locating, retrieving and extracting it.

We estimate that because there is no specific code on our system for rocks on verges, an officer would have to manually review in excess of 5,500 enquires to determine if they were related to the request then collate the relevant information. This has been estimated to exceed the 18-hour limit of the Act. Your request has been refused under section 12(2) of the Act.

However, in order to fulfil our obligations under Section 16 of the FOI Act to advise and assist you, we advise that we have only received two corporate complaints for the last 12 months: using the key words: rocks, verges, stones.

The supply of information in response to a FOI/EIR request does not confer an automatic right to re-use the information. You can use any information supplied for the purposes of private study and

non-commercial research without requiring further permission. Similarly, information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting. An exception to this is photographs. Please contact us if you wish to use the information for any other purpose.

For information, we publish a variety of information such as: <u>FOI/EIR Disclosure Log</u>, <u>Publication Scheme</u>, <u>Facts about Coventry</u> and <u>Open Data</u> that you may find of useful if you are looking for information in the future.
