

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Jennaway Gardens and Ethelred Close)
(Waiting Restrictions) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce the following waiting restrictions:

Jennaway Gardens/ Little Cryfield	Proposed prohibition of waiting (double yellow lines) for junction protection – preventing waiting within 10 metres of the junction
Jennaway Gardens/ Ethelred Close	Proposed prohibition of waiting (double yellow lines) for junction protection – preventing waiting within 10 metres of the junction
Jennaway Gardens	Proposed, prohibition of waiting, Monday to Friday, 8am-6pm (single yellow line) for the remaining extent of the road (i.e. where no double yellow lines are proposed)
Ethelred Close	Proposed, prohibition of waiting, Monday to Friday, 8am-6pm (single yellow line) for the remaining extent of the road (i.e. where no double yellow lines are proposed)

The restrictions are proposed to prevent parking at junctions and to assist to prevent potential commuter parking associated with the locations proximity to the University of Warwick.
