

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Eaton Road) (One Way & Prohibition of Left Turn) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The Order proposes to:-

- i) prohibit the left turn from Ringway St Patrick's clockwise off slip on to Eaton Road; and
- ii) make Eaton Road one way, from its junction with Ringway St Patrick's clockwise off slip to a point 36 metres south of said junction Vehicles will only be permitted to travel in a northerly direction (towards the ring road).

The proposed measures will facilitate the free flow of traffic in the area.
