## City of Coventry (City Centre High Street Area)(Prohibition of Driving & No Entry)(Experimental) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Experimental Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order"), which will come into force on 3 June 2024.

The Order will restrict access to CUCKOO LANE, GREYFRIARS LANE, HAY LANE, HIGH STREET, PEPPER LANE, PRIORY ROW, ST MICHAELS AVENUE and TRINITY CHURCHYARD to Permit Holders Only (Monday to Saturday, 10am to 6pm).

Buses, Hackney Carriages, bicycles, pedestrians, Statutory Undertakers, Emergency Services and Highway Maintenance vehicles will be exempt at all times. BAYLEY LANE will not be passable to through traffic and access into HIGH STREET from LITTLE PARK STREET will be prohibited.

The Order will be implemented initially on an experimental basis for eighteen (18) months, after which time it will be reviewed and a decision made on whether it should continue in force indefinitely or be abandoned.

Objections must be made in writing and must state the grounds on which they are made.

Should any person wish to question the validity of this Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the power conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
