Notice of Making

City of Coventry (Knights Templar Way Area) (Prohibition of Driving) (Permanent) Order 2024

Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Order ("the Permanent Order"), which comes into operation on 19th July 2024.

The effect of the Permanent Order is to make permanent of the 'City of Coventry (Knights Templar Way Area) (Prohibition of Driving)(Experimental) Order 2023' ("the Experimental Order").

The Experimental Order was made in response to residents' concerns about parking and driving in the Knights Templar Way area when children are being taken and/or collected from Templars Primary School. It had the effect of prohibiting driving (except for permit holders) on the length of roads listed below, Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm:-

Knights Templar Way	Whole Length
Lomsey Close	Whole Length
Monks Field Close	Whole Length

Residents on the affected lengths of road can apply for permits.

The Experimental Order was trialled for a period of seventeen (17) months and the Council with the implementation of the Permanent Order, intends to give the scheme permanent effect.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder, or of any relevant Act, has not been complied with may, within six (6) weeks from today, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
