PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Stoneleigh Road & Gibbet Hill Road)(40mph Speed Limit Revocation) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

It is proposed to revoke the existing 40mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:-

STONELEIGH ROAD - From the City of Coventry Authority Boundary to its junction with Kenilworth Road (A429)

GIBBET HILL ROAD - From a point 40m south east of its junction with the access road formerly known as Cryfield Grange to its junction with Kenilworth Road (A429).

Removal of the above speed limits will mean that those lengths of road noted above will revert to being a 30mph national speed limit, by virtue of having Restricted Road status.
