Thank you for your request for information relating to Stop Signs inside Coventry.

You have requested the following information:

I am writing to enquire about the number and location of traffic stop signs in the city of Coventry. To be clear, I am referring to the Stop and give way sign as defined in the Highway Code.

The information required is therefore two parts:

- 1) The number of stop signs inside Coventry.
- 2) The location of stop signs. This can be any clear description of location, such as the name of a road, and the road the stop sign is at a junction with.

For Questions 1 and 2, we confirm that we do not hold this information and are advising you as per Section 1(1) of the Act. We do not hold an inventory of stops signs in Coventry.

For information, we publish a variety of information such as: <u>FOI/EIR Disclosure Log</u>, <u>Publication Scheme</u>, <u>Facts about Coventry</u> and <u>Open Data</u> that you may find of useful if you are looking for information in the future.
