Experimental Traffic Regulation Orders School Streets Coventry 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the following Experimental Traffic Regulation Orders ("the Orders"), which come into effect on 4th September 2024.

The Orders have been proposed in order to create 'School Streets', which assist to reduce vehicular traffic in streets near to schools for a short time at the start and end of the school day. This reduces congestion, improves air quality and road safety. It also encourages walking and cycling to school. The Orders create four (4) School Street Schemes

The Orders are:-

i) City of Coventry (East Street & South Street) (Pedestrianised School Street) (Experimental) Order 2024

The effect of this order will be to prohibit driving (except for permit holders) on: **East Street** - between its junctions with Paynes Lane and Napier Street **South Street** - between its junctions with East Street and Read Street Monday to Friday, 8.15am to 9.15am and 3.15pm to 3.45pm Creating a school street scheme for Southfields Primary School

ii) City of Coventry (Oliver Street) (Pedestrianised School Street) (Experimental) Order 2024

The effect of this order will be to prohibit driving (except for permit holders) on **Oliver Street** – between its junctions with Freeman Street and its cul de sac end Monday to Friday, 8.00am to 9.00am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm Creating a school street scheme for Stanton Bridge Primary School

iii) City of Coventry (Potters Green Road) (Pedestrianised School Street) (Experimental) Order 2024

The effect of this order will be to prohibit driving (except for permit holders) on Potters Green Road – between its junctions with Woodway Lane and Frankwell Drive Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 9.30am and 2.45pm to 3.45pm Creating a school street scheme for Cardinal Wiseman RC School

iv) City of Coventry (Ravensdale Road) (Pedestrianised School Street) (Experimental) Order 2024

The effect of this order will be to prohibit driving (except for permit holders) on Ravensdale Road – whole length Monday to Friday, 8.15am to 9.15am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm Creating a school street scheme for Ravensdale Primary School

Residents on the affected lengths of road can apply for permits. Each School Street Scheme having a different permit identifier, which can only be used in one scheme.

The Orders will be implemented initially on an experimental basis for eighteen (18) months, after which time they will be reviewed. The Council may then make all or some of the Orders permanent or abandon them.
