What is Children's Speech and Language Therapy?

Coventry Children's Speech and Language Therapy Service is a specialist service which aims to support children and young people aged 0-19 to reach their full speech, language, and communication potential. The team works with babies, children, and young people who have difficulties with:

- Speech sounds
- Language (understanding and talking)
- Feeding and swallowing
- Stammering
- Selective mutism
- Hearing impairment
- Voice disorders

How to refer?

If your child is registered with a Coventry GP they can be referred to our service. Anyone can make a referral on behalf of a child including parents/carers, education staff and health professionals.

How do we work?

All children and young people accepted to the service will be offered an assessment with a speech and language therapist. These will usually take place virtually or face to face at the City of Coventry Health Centre. Most appointments last up to 1 hour. Pay and display parking is available on-site. We are approximately a 5-minute walk from Pool Meadow bus station in Coventry City Centre.

The Children's Speech & Language Therapy Service is located on the fourth floor of the City of Coventry Health Centre. Lifts are available.

To get the most out of intervention we work together with the child, family, education settings, such as schools and nurseries, and other important people surrounding the child.
