Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) Request ID: FOI641663695

Thank you for your request for information relating to Electro-Magnetic Frequency Waves (5G technology) - insurance cover.

You have requested the following information:

Please would the Council send me the exact clause in their public liability insurance that shows that the Council is indemnified against claims on the Council for harm caused by EMF radiation.

In response to your request, we confirm that the Council's public liability insurance has the following Insuring Clause, which states the following:

"The insurer agrees to indemnify the insured by the terms of this insured section against legal liability to pay damages or compensation, including claimant costs recoverable from the insured, as a result of personal injury, damage, denial of access or nuisance that occurs during the period of insurance and arises out of and in connection with the business".

In the policy, bodily injury is defined as "death, disease, illness, physical and mental injury of or to an individual".

If someone was injured by radiation that was caused by the negligence of the Council, then a claim for damages would be covered under the above clauses because it is not excluded anywhere else in the policy.

The supply of information in response to a FOI request does not confer an automatic right to re-

use the information. You can use any information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research without requiring further permission. Similarly, information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting. An exception to this is photographs. Please contact us if you wish to use the information for any other purpose.
