Notice of Making - Traffic Regulation Orders

City of Coventry (Palmer Lane)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2024 & City of Coventry (Palmer Lane)(No Entry) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), has made the above Traffic Regulation Orders ("the Orders") which will come into operation on 1st October 2024

The Orders form part of improvement works to create a pedestrian only open space free from traffic on part of PALMER LANE.

The Orders are:-

i) City of Coventry (Palmer Lane)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2024

The effect of this order shall be to restrict access for motor vehicles to part of Palmer Lane, 24 hours a day for 365 days a year.

The part of PALMER LANE that is affected is from its pedestrian junction with BURGES (between properties 23 & 24 Burges) to a point 64m easterly and 68m southerly of the aforementioned point..

ii) City of Coventry (Palmer Lane)(No Entry) Order 2024

The effect of this order shall be to prohibit vehicular access into Palmer Lane from its junction with Burges. Exemptions are provided for cyclists, Emergency Services and Statutory Undertakers.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from date the order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
