

Notice of Intent
Proposed Installation of Controlled Pedestrian Crossing (TOUCAN) &
Establishment of Cycle Track - London Road

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under sections 65 (1), 65(2) and 66 of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby propose to introduce a length of 2-way Segregated Cycle Track along London Road (northeastern side) from a point approx. sixty (60) metres southeast of its junction with Allard Way to its junction with Abbey Road and along London Road (southwestern side) from its junction with Tonbridge Road for a distance of approx thirty (30) metres in a southeasterly direction.

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to install a controlled crossing (TOUCAN) on London Road, approx eighteen (18) metres southeast of its junction with Tonbridge Road

The proposed crossing facility should assist pedestrians and pedal cyclists to cross the road. The works should be completed by the end of Autumn 2025.
