## CITY OF COVENTRY (CENTRAL EARLSDON) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) EXEMPTION ORDER 2024

Coventry City Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 124(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 2024 and may be cited as the "City of Coventry (Central Earlsdon) (One Way Traffic) Exemption Order 2024".
- 2. i) In this Order
  - a) reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this Order so numbered
  - b) the following expressions shall have the meanings assigned to them:-

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning ascribed to it as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

- (ii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The Order referred to in the Schedule to this Order is hereby amended to the extent detailed therein by the inclusion of the following exemptions:

Nothing in this Order shall apply to:

- (a) Pedal Cycles
- 4. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be read and construed as not being in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
