## Notice of Intent Proposed Removal of Controlled Pedestrian Crossing facility

Notice is hereby given that, Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), intends to remove a controlled pedestrian crossing facility (PUFFIN)

The controlled crossing facility to be removed is located on Queen Victoria Road approximately 18m south of its junction with Croft Road.

The PUFFIN Crossing is to be removed as part of changes to the road layout needed to implement the Coventry Very Light Rail (CVLR) Live Environment Construction Test (LECT). The existing controlled pedestrian crossing on Queen Victoria Road (outside the old IKEA building) will remain. The removal works should be completed by the end of January 2025.
