

PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

City of Coventry (Primrose Hill Street Area) **(Red Route & Waiting Restrictions) Order 2025**

Notice is hereby given that Coventry City Council ("the Council"), pursuant to its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order ("the Order").

The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a 'red route' extending along White Street, Primrose Hill Street, Victoria Street and part of King William Street and into the following adjoining side streets: Canterbury Street, Clifton Street, Cox Street, Nelson Street, Swanswell Street, Vine Street, Wellington Street.

The proposals will install no stopping at any time restrictions (double red lines) along the route in areas where waiting is currently prevented (as shown by double yellow lines). Existing limited waiting parking bays and loading bays will remain in place, apart from Wellington Street where it is proposed to replace part of the existing limited waiting bay with a 'loading only, 8am-6pm' bay.

The details of the changes proposed by this Order are contained in the Statement of Reasons and the Map Tiles all of which are available on the Council's website (see link below).
