



STATUTORY LIST OF BUILDINGS OF SPECIAL ARCHITECTURAL OR HISTORIC INTEREST

List as at September 2018

Buildings are classified in grades to show their relative importance as follows:-

- Grade I These are buildings of exceptional interest (only about 4 per cent of listed buildings are so graded).
- Grade II These are buildings of special interest which warrant every effort being made to preserve them (some particularly important buildings in Grade II are classified Grade II*).

Churches in ecclesiastical use are exempt from listed building controls under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, Section 60.

Some of those in Coventry are still listed under the old system as grades A, B and C. Recently, the DCMS have been gradually regrading these to I, II or II*.

Scheduled Ancient Monuments are subject to the Ancient Monuments Acts which take precedence over listed building procedures.

In the attached list (C) after the grade indicates that the building is owned by the City Council, (M) that the building is also scheduled as an Ancient Monument and (D) that the building previously listed has now been demolished.
