I refer to our meeting the other day and now enclose the Part B Surrender Form duly completed and signed for your perusal.

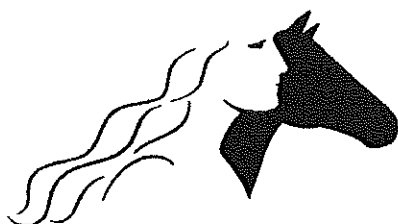
