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Inclusive Group Work

Children who feel included enjoy and achieve. This is why our team have innovated and applied a range of solutions to build **inclusive and successful classrooms**.

For example, the FITOS package provides staff with an opportunity to create, within their classrooms, a climate where difference becomes accepted and where children's strengths become a uniting and positive force.

Many of our social interventions also develop children's problem-solving skills.

Peer Group Consultation

Peer group consultation empowers groups of young people to recognise their own strengths and difficulties and identify areas in which they want to make change.

The intervention encourages children to reflect on their own behaviour and to self evaluate.

Circle of Friends

This is a short-term inclusive intervention that focuses on an individual pupil by developing and sustaining a supportive group of peers who are involved in problem-solving with that young person and targeting support.

FITOS: KS2 Strengths Package

'Fostering Inclusion through Circles and Strengths' package is a whole class intervention aimed at increasing pupils' empathy towards children with SEN by raising their own awareness by a range of difficulties as well as strengths in both themselves and others.

Social Skills Groups

This involves forming and running small groups in collaboration with school staff. Whilst the focus of the work is on developing social skills in young people, our EPs ensure the package is tailored to a schools needs and builds capacity in your school.
